Explanation of Poll Tax Class Codes

No. 1, First Class: includes Farmers in possession of a Farm with six Neat Cattle or Black Cattle, and/or a Horse, anyone owning a Fishing Boat or Passage Boat.

No. 2, Second Class: includes Farmers having more than six Neat Cattle or Black Cattle, and/or Horses, a Mechanic or Handicraftman carrying on any trade, a Master Workman for Hire or Wages, every Owner, Master or Mate of every Registered Vessel.

No. 3, Third Class: Barrister and Attorney at Law, Physician, Surgeon, Apothecary, Merchant and Shopkeeper.

No. 4, Fourth Class: every person enjoying a salary of 30£ and upward, not amounting to 40£.

No. 5, Fifth Class: every person enjoying a salary upward of 40£ but not amounting to 50£.

No. 6, Sixth Class: every person enjoying a salary over 60£, Widows and Officers of the Army and Navy excepted.

No. 7, Seventh Class: every person being a male above the age the age of 21 years and not included in any of the above Classes.

No. 8, Eighth Class: every person with Real Property of the value of 500£ and upwards.
